Lesson Overview:

In this lesson, students will learn vocabulary and phrases needed for shopping for clothes in their communities. Clothing tag information will be discussed, along with understanding of American clothes and shoe sizing. Students will learn and recite frequently used phrases in role plays for this setting, such as, *I am looking for _____*, *I would like to try this on*, and *Where is the dressing room?* Additionally, students will participate in a clothes shopping listening activity. Students will have the opportunity to go to a mall as an extension activity.

Objectives:

- Students will recognize and say a limited number of words related to basic clothing items.
- Students will be able to identify and name different sizes for clothing and shoes.
- Students will become familiar with information on a clothing tag.
- Students will learn and recite frequently used phrases when shopping for clothing.
- Students will listen for and recognize clothing vocabulary in a listening activity.
