Lesson Overview:

In this lesson, students will be introduced to American kitchen and cooking vocabulary. For grammar, they will learn and practice prepositions of location. In addition, they will be introduced to basic cooking measurements and practice reading a recipe. They will be asked to share their home countries traditions around food. Activities include a Basketball Vocabulary game, making Chex Mix, and using kitchen realia to practice prepositions of location. Students will have the opportunity to visit a local food bank as an extension activity.

Objectives:

- Student will be able to recognize and say vocabulary related to American kitchens and cooking.
- Student will learn and practice prepositions of location.
- Student will learn basic measurements and practice cooking skills for everyday living.
- Student will be exposed to typical American food traditions and discuss their home countries traditions around food.
