Lesson Overview:

This lesson's focus is homes. Students will learn vocabulary used to talk about rooms in their home. They will be taught language to describe the activities that take place in each room, i.e., living room: watch TV, visit; bathroom: take a bath, brush your teeth, etc. They will practice saying and writing their home address and will participate in role plays for welcoming guests into their home. Students will attend workshops on keeping safe in their homes and saving money on their energy bills to support this lesson. In addition, a field trip to a local historical home will be offered.

Objectives:

- Students will recognize and say a limited number of words to describe everyday activities that take place in their homes.
- Students will recognize and use prepositions of location in short sentences.
- Students will be able to say and write their home address.
- Students will use short words and phrases to use when welcoming visitors to their homes.

Materials:

- Conversation card: *Greetings*
- Card set: My Home
- Computer for Google Earth search, or local map
- Worksheets: Personal information form, Vocabulary list
- TPR objects for each student i.e., paper bowls, pencil, blocks
- 4 large sheets of paper, glue
- Home furniture and furnishings cut from catalogues or ads
