Lesson Overview:

In this lesson, students will be introduced to vocabulary associated with weather and clothing, and will learn what clothes are appropriate for different seasons. They will be introduced to and practice the use of phrasal verbs and the present perfect tense associated with clothing. Activities include a weather report listening activity, *what are you wearing* game, dress-up relay and learning how to read high and low temperatures. A field trip to a local weather station will be organized.

Objectives:

- Students will be able to recognize and say vocabulary related to the weather, clothing and the different seasons.
- Students will be able to identify high and low temperatures from different cities.
- Students will learn self care skills by choosing appropriate clothing for the different seasons.
- Student will decide what clothes they should wear that day based on a weather report.
- Students will use phrasal verbs associated with clothing.
- Student will learn and practice these grammar structures: *It is (It's) _____ (sunny, rainy, etc)* and *I am (I'm) wearing _____ (pants, etc).*

- Conversation Card: *Seasons*
- Clothing realia for key vocabulary list (including hanger) and relay
- Colored markers
- Sentence strips
- Worksheets: Vocabulary, Weather Words, Temperature, Listening Teacher Script
