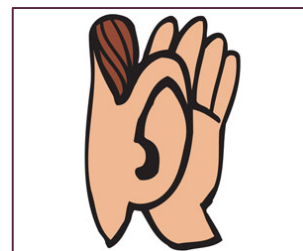


WEATHER REPORT LISTENING TEACHER SCRIPT

Have the students come up in groups (3-4 students) to the pile of clothes. They will listen to the weather report and decide on three pieces of clothes they should wear. Read two times. Encourage students to talk with each other to decide. Have the students say the items they picked to wear.



1. It is July 5th. It is hot and sunny. The temperature is 90 degrees.
2. It is snowy and very cold. The temperature is 20 degrees. It is winter.
3. It is spring. It is rainy and cloudy. I am going to walk to the store.
4. It is a fall morning. It is October 9th. It is sunny but cold. I am going to pick pumpkins.
5. It is stormy outside and very wet. The temperature is 50 degrees. I am going to school.
6. It is hot day in the middle of August. I am going to a restaurant.
